



Mount Rinjani

Equipment List & Packing Guide 2025

It is very important that people coming to Lombok to climb Mount Rinjani come prepared. Despite Lombok being in the tropics, it can get cold - temperature drops as altitude increases. At night temperatures can fall to 1-2 degrees centigrade on the crater rim, and if it is windy, the wind chill can be significant. Rinjani Dawn Adventures has a limited amount of clothing and equipment it can lend to customers, but we suggest strongly that you bring your own, wherever possible:

Customer Essential Packing List		
Item	Description	Comments
Trekking Shoes	We recommend hiking boots, or trail-running trainers.	Some people hike in normal trainers, so long as they have good grip it should be manageable.
Backpack	We recommend a 40l backpack – enough to carry all of your personal possessions.	Suitable for hiking.
Warm Jacket	Insulated jacket – can be down filled or fleece lined. Suitable for winter / temperatures down to 0 degrees C.	Essential for staying warm at night whilst camping, and when going to the summit.
Warm / thermal layers	Warm top and leggings for night time.	Recommend lightweight merino, but customer personal preference.
Waterproof Shell or Poncho	Lightweight waterproof jacket & trousers, or Poncho.	In rainy season, Lombok can experience heavy rainfall.
Hat & Gloves	Warm hat, and fleece-lined / winter gloves.	Night time & summit.
Head Torch	Useful for tent at night & going to the toilet, essential for summit.	
Small Dry Bag	Dry Bag, or plastic bags	In case it rains, we recommend you waterproof your clothes.

Other Suggestions		
Item	Description	Comments
Personal First Aid Kit	Plasters, Anti-inflammatories, paracetamol, and personal medication you require.	We cannot prescribe drugs and medication.
Flip flops / sandals / thongs	Cheap sandals / flip-flops	Great for airing feet at rest stops and at

		the end of the day.
Camelback	Water on demand	Our porters and guides will offer you bottled water, but Camelbacks make drinking regularly easy.
Swimming Costume	Swimming trunks / bikini	If doing the 3 or 4 day trek, which includes the lake and hot springs
Hat, Sunglasses, Sun-block		It can be bright and hot!
Dust Mask	Basic dust mask	At certain times of year, parts of the trail can get dusty, especially coming down from the summit.
Sleeping bag liner	Thin, lightweight liner for additional comfort.	We clean our sleeping bags after every trip, but recommend people use a liner.

Apart from the items listed above, you will naturally want to bring enough clothes, socks, and toiletries to see you through your trip. You will sweat a lot due to the heat, humidity, and exertion! You may also want to bring electronics such as camera and phone, and a small amount of money, should you wish to tip your guide and porters at the end of the trip. Most people can fit everything they need into a 40l daypack.
